

German designer Sebastian Herkner, who has gained international recognition for his ability to reconcile organic shapes with austere sentiments, has created a multifunctional bench for Wendelbo. Rest works as both a small sofa or a large chair and is suitable in private homes as well as in public settings.

Sebastian Herkner has developed an elegant bench for Wendelbo with his usual sense of function, materials and detailing. The bench, dubbed Rest, is intended specifically for a short break or as a gentle, private starting point for a work situation. In keeping with Sebastian Herkner's design philosophy, Rest reaches out to its user. For that reason, the DNA of the design appeals to emotion and reason at once.

Rest simply consists of two bent, padded elements that meet in a gentle embrace – a design concept that makes the structure self-supporting and eliminates the need for legs or plinths. At the same time, the coupling between the upwardly aspirational back and the horizontal seat gives Rest a dynamic, light-and-airy look.

One end of the slim seat is shielded by the back, while the other is slightly distanced from the backrest. It allows you to sit across the bench in a relaxed position, leaning on the backrest, or to strike a more informal pose at the opposite end. The asymmetry ensures that the bench can be used in various ways while adding a certain transparency to the design.

Sebastian Herkner explains that he imagines the bench as a functional, decorative element in a small shop, a lounging setting, a corner of the bedroom or other places where there is a need to wait, take a break or sit and do work on a tablet.

The bench is available with an integrated, round table ideal for your coffee cup or book, or to provide a firm surface for your laptop.
